

HOST FACILITY REQUIREMENTS

BREWERIES, WINERIES, COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, OR OTHER APPROVED LOCATIONS

that meet specific infrastructure and operational requirements now have the option to obtain a **HOST FACILITY** permit issued by the Riverside County Department of Environmental Health (DEH). This permit allows caterers to serve food (with limited preparation) at these locations for up to 4 hours in a 12-hour timeframe.



HAND SINK

Permanently installed
Hard-plumbed
Warm water 100°F - 108°F
Hand soap in dispenser
Single-use paper towels in dispenser



WAREWASHING

Approved 3-compartment sink with indirect wastewater connection, or other method approved by DEH



RESTROOM

Within 200 feet from food prep
Easily-accessible
Agreement letter may be required



FOOD SERVICE LOCATION

Cleanable floors
Overhead protection



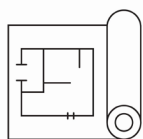
MOP SINK

Curbed mop sink
Hot water at least 120°F
Approved backflow prevention device



OTHER

Consult with local wastewater authority regarding grease interceptor requirement
Comply with all other applicable codes (e.g., Fire, Building, etc.)



To apply to be a Host Facility, contact DEH, submit 3 sets of plans, and complete the Host Facility Permitting Form.
