**FOR THE EL SOBRANTE LANDFILL PERMIT MODIFICATION
RECEIVED BY THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
HEALTH LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: USA Waste of California, Inc. submitted an application to modify the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the EL Sobrante Landfill (SWIS 33-AA-0217) received by the Riverside County Department of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) on April 30, 2018. The permit modification package was reviewed and found to be complete and correct by the LEA on May 29, 2018. This application package includes:

- Relocation of the facility maintenance building and redesign to future storm water ponds to limit offsite grading and grading in sensitive habitats
 - Reduction and reconfiguration of grading from 645 acres to 618 acres, while reducing offsite grading from 11 acres to 4 acres
- Updated Estimated Closure Date to 2051
- Addition of cathode ray tube (CRT) waste, CRT televisions and contaminated soils to list of acceptable waste.
- Removed auto shredder fluff from accepted wastes
- Addition of a 4th permanent scale
- Addition of a wheel wash station
