**FOR THE OASIS SANITARY LANDFILL PERMIT MODIFICATION
RECEIVED BY THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
HEALTH LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Riverside County Department of Waste Resources submitted an application to modify the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the Oasis Sanitary Landfill (SWIS 33-AA-0015) on August 30, 2018. The Riverside County Department of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) reviewed the application package and found to be complete and correct on September 19, 2018.

The SWFP Modification application addresses the change of the closure date from September 2055 to May 2045, adjusting design capacity based on current survey, and updating the property acreage from 165.36 to 159.67 due to a property line adjustment. The change in acreage does not affect the disposal area.
