PROJECT DESCRIPTION: CR&R Incorporated submitted an application to amend the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for the Perris Transfer Station and MRF (SWIS 33-AA-0239). This application was received by the Riverside County Department of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) on January 18, 2019. The package was reviewed and found to be complete and correct by the LEA on February 7, 2019. This application package includes:

- Updated details and clarification of various facility operations pertaining to the handling of solid waste.
- Addition of a new sorting and shredding system within the Material Recovery Facility.
- Updated details of current and future layout and operation of the Anaerobic Digester.
