As part of our transition away from in-house testing to American Water Works Association (AWWA) certification, Riverside County Ordinance 525 requires that the expiration date on the Certificate of Competency issued by our Department coincide with your AWWA expiration date. As such, this transition may result in your Certification from our Department having an expiration period significantly shorter than 3 years. We expect this to be a one-time occurrence for each tester as expiration dates get in phase with each other.
