Project Description

On December 19, 2024, Riverside County Department of Waste Resources submitted a new application for a solid waste facility permit (SWFP) for a compost facility located on 5.2 acres within the Lamb Canyon Landfill. Riverside County Department of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has found the Registration Permit application to be complete and correct and accepted the application for filing on January 9, 2025. This application package includes:
