FOOD HANDLER CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

County of Riverside Ordinance No. 567 (Riverside County Code 8.44) requires anyone whose job includes the handling of food, beverages, or utensils be certified in safe food handling practices. This program is called the Food Handler Certification Program and its primary goal is to prevent foodborne illness. All employees must have a current Food Handler Certificate within **SEVEN DAYS** of beginning employment in a food facility.

To receive a Food Handler Certificate, you must read the Food Handler Study Guide and pass a 50 question multiple-choice examination. A passing score is 35 or more correct answers. There is a fee charged to take the exam. Fees can be paid in cash, money order or by credit card and a valid photo identification must also be presented prior to examination. You have the option to come in person to any of the eight Environmental Health offices listed below or go online to take the examination at www.rivcoeh.org. The online examination can be accessed only from the link provided on the Department website.

Once you have passed the exam, a Food Handler Certificate will be issued to you, or you can print one if taking the online test. The certificate is valid for two years and it must be displayed at your place of employment. Photocopies will not be accepted at your worksite.

A person who fails the exam may retake it within one week. The exam may be taken a maximum of two additional times within seven days of the initial testing date at no additional charge. If a certificate is lost or a second certificate is needed for an additional job site, a duplicate may be issued in one of our Environmental Health offices for a reduced fee or online at no additional charge. Be sure to have valid identification.
