COMMONLY ENCOUNTERED FOOD POISONINGS AND SYMPTOMS

Bacillus cereus Campylobacter enteritis

Symptoms: Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea,

abdominal pain

Onset Time: 6-15 hours*

Food Involved: Boiled / fried rice, cereals, soups,

custards, sauces, meatloaf, sausage,

cooked vegetables

Specimens to collect: Stool, vomitus

*Heat labile type (diarrheal) has an onset time of 8-16 hrs.

Symptoms: Abdominal pain, diarrhea, fever,

malaise, headaches

Onset Time: 2-5 days

Food Involved: Raw milk, water, raw poultry

or meat

Specimens to collect: Stools, rectal swabs, blood

Clostridium perfringens

Abdominal pain, diarrhea Symptoms:

8-22 hours Onset Time:

Cooked meat, poultry, gravy Food Involved:

Specimens to collect:

Chemical Contamination

Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal Symptoms:

pain

6-24 hours Onset Time:

Food Involved: Chemicals induced into any food item

Specimens to collect: Stool, vomitus

Escherichia coli

Symptoms: Abdominal pain, diarrhea, muscular

pain, vomiting, chills, headache, nausea,

fever

Onset Time: 1-4 days

Food Involved: Various foods, water Stools, rectal swabs

Specimens to collect:

Salmonella

Symptoms: Abdominal pain, diarrhea, chills fever,

nausea, vomiting, malaise

Onset Time: 6-72 hours

Food Involved: Poultry, meat, eggs

Stools, rectal swabs, blood Specimens to collect:

Shigellosis

Abdominal pain, diarrhea, fever, bloody Symptoms:

mucoid stools, tenesmus

Onset Time: 1-2 days

Salads, water Food Involved:

Stools, rectal swabs Specimens to collect:

Staphylococcal (Staphylococcus aureus)

Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea Symptoms:

abrupt/violent abdominal pain

Onset Time: 30 minutes - 6 hours

Ham, meat, poultry, cream filled Food Involved:

pastry, food mixtures, milk, cheese

Stools, vomitus, rectal swabs nasal Specimens to collect:

swabs

Norovirus Listeria

Symptoms: Diarrhea, nausea, stomach pain,

vomiting, fever, headache, body

aches

Onset Time: 12-48 hours

Food Involved: Any food item contaminated

with stool or vomit from an

infected person

Specimens to collect: Stool, Vomitus

Symptoms:

<u>Pregnant Women</u>: flu-like symptoms

Other than Pregnant: headache, stiff neck, confusion, loss of balance, convulsions, fever, muscle aches

Onset Time: 1-3 weeks

Food Involved: Soft cheeses, raw sprouts, melons,

hot dogs, lunch meats, smoked

seafood

Blood Specimens to collect:
