**Registering as a recovery organization is a free way to connect with your community on a larger scale and gain access to donations from a variety of edible food generators!**

## Senate Bill 1383: *What is it?*

A statewide target goal of reducing the disposal of organic waste by 75% by 2025 with an additional goal of rescuing at least 20% of edible food fit for human consumption currently going to waste.



## Don't Worry!

- Registration with Environmental Health does not require any fees
- Recovery contracts are not shared with other recovery organizations
- Your facility will not be subject to additional fees or mandated upgrades
- \*Please be advised minimum health and safety requirements apply

## Why Participate?

- Reduce hunger in your community while providing safe, sanitary foods for an often vulnerable population
- Build connections to a larger regional network of commercial food providers, transporters, and pantries
- Enhance legitimacy of your organization by becoming an approved, inspected source of edible food
- Contribute to California's solid waste reduction targets for a greener tomorrow

Type of Food	Registration Needed
100% Prepackaged Food <u>NO</u> Perishable Food (TYPE A)	Recommended
100% Prepackaged Food <u>WITH</u> Perishable Food <u>AND PARTNERS</u> with a Food Bank (TYPE B)	Recommended
100% Prepackaged Food <u>WITH</u> Perishable Food and <u>DOES NOT PARTNER</u> with a Food Bank (TYPE B)	Prepackaged Charitable Feeding Registration
Re-Heat and Portion Commercially Prepared Food to Hot Hold for Same Day Service (TYPE C)	Charitable Feeding Registration
Heat, Portion, and Assemble Small Amount of Unpackaged Commercially Prepared Food (TYPE D)	Charitable Feeding Registration
All Other Food Processes	Food Facility Permit

## What to Expect When Inspected!

### What the Inspector is Checking For:

- Hot and cold running water
- Maintain facility enclosed to exclude vermin
- Hot and cold holding temperatures (if applicable)
- Safe food storage
