If Legionella has been implicated at your facility, follow these instructions.

You will need to have an ELITE lab conduct the sampling and testing.

- An ELITE (Environmental *Legionella* Isolation Techniques Evaluation) lab is certified by the Centers for Disease Control to effectively and accurately test for the existence of Legionella.
