

The pump was oversized for the task and therefore caused splash back to occur onto the one employee who was operating the hand pump. This employee suffered burns to eyes, face, and neck and was transported via ambulance to a hospital for further medical attention.

Description of Initial Mitigation Measures (evacuation, berming, absorption, containerizing)	The facility self-evacuated the immediate area of the spill and the affected employee utilized an on-site decontamination shower and eyewash station prior to arrival by emergency services. The air handling units at the facility were utilized to circulate the air. Material is contained to the hazmat storage area inside the facility.
