

# How to obtain a Registered Environmental Health Specialist position with Riverside County Environmental Health

#### 

Complete at least a bachelor's degree—meeting the minimum educational requirements.

(cdph.ca.gov REHS)

Have your college transcripts evaluated—download application from the CPS website:

Mail an official copy of your transcripts with fully completed application and \$245.25 evaluation fee to:

Available on California Department of Public Health (CDPH) website. Mail application with non-refundable \$178 fee to:

California Dept. of Public Health EHS Registration Program MS 7404, IMS K-2 P.O. Box 997377 Sacramento, CA 95899

The application for registration with CDPH may be submitted at the same time you apply for a transcript evaluation with CPS.

CPS will conduct an evaluation of your transcripts and CDPH will issue you a certification letter detailing what educational and training requirements you will need to complete before taking the REHS exam.

Possession of the certification letter is required prior to applying with Riverside County.

## Step Two '----Apply for a Position

Once you are in possession of the state certification letter, you may apply with Riverside County at:

\*You must upload your resumé and state certification letter to your Job Gateway account profile at time of application.

#### NOTE:

The hiring process consists of 3 interviews with various members of the Department before a job offer can be made.

You will need to bring a copy of your state certification letter to the interview. If you have any questions regarding the interview process contact (951) 955-3510.

### Step Three -----Take the REHS Exam

It is required that you take and pass the REHS exam within 36 months of being hired.

A non-refundable \$235 fee is due at the time of the exam. The exam is offered 3 times a year (March, July, and November) in Sacramento and Los Angeles.

Maintain your REHS certification and get the necessary continuing education credit to renew your registration every 2 years.

Once you receive your exam results and have passed, send \$327 to CDPH for your REHS registration certificate.
